How do I Use ACES?

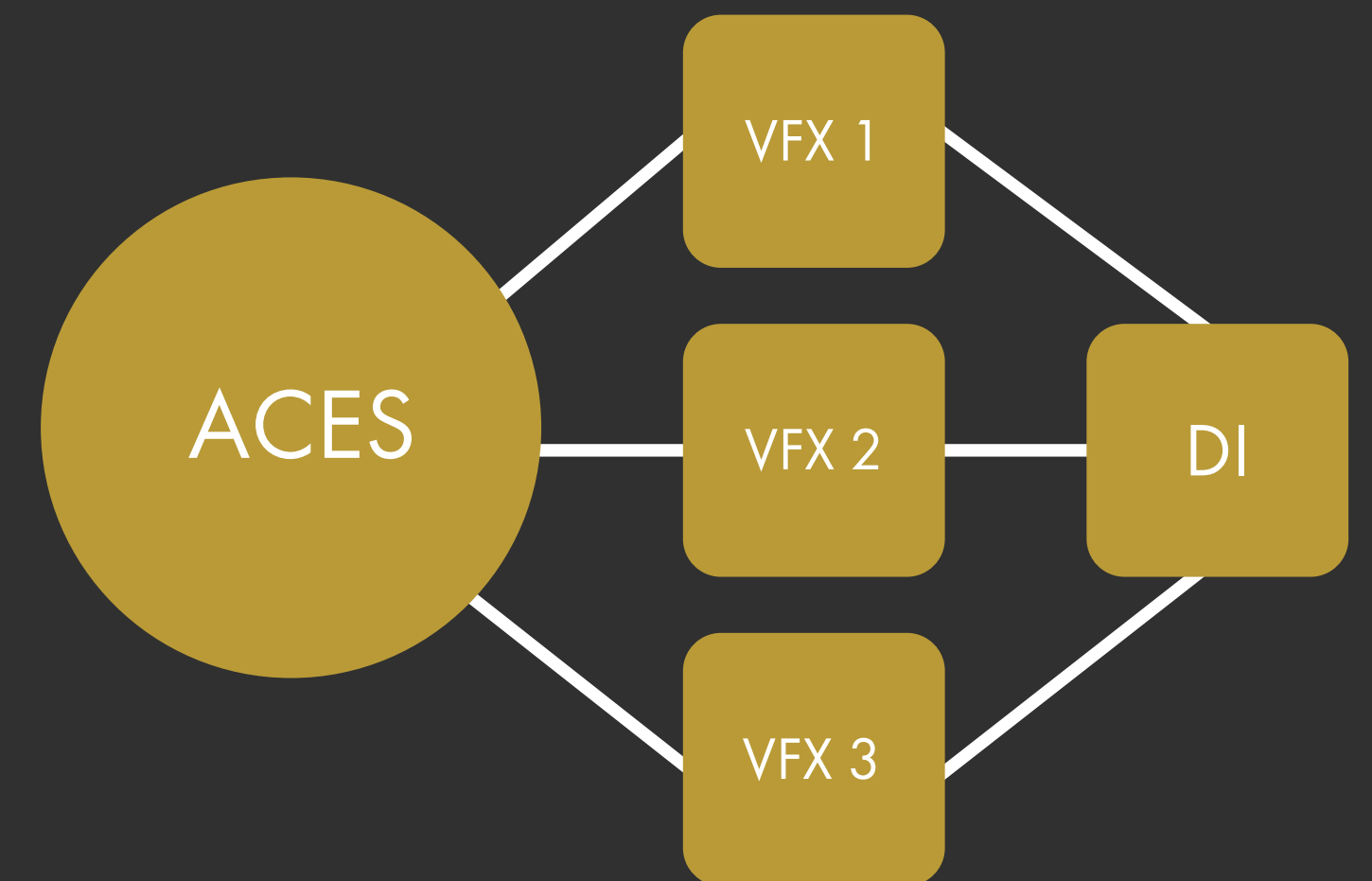

Who Benefits from ACES?

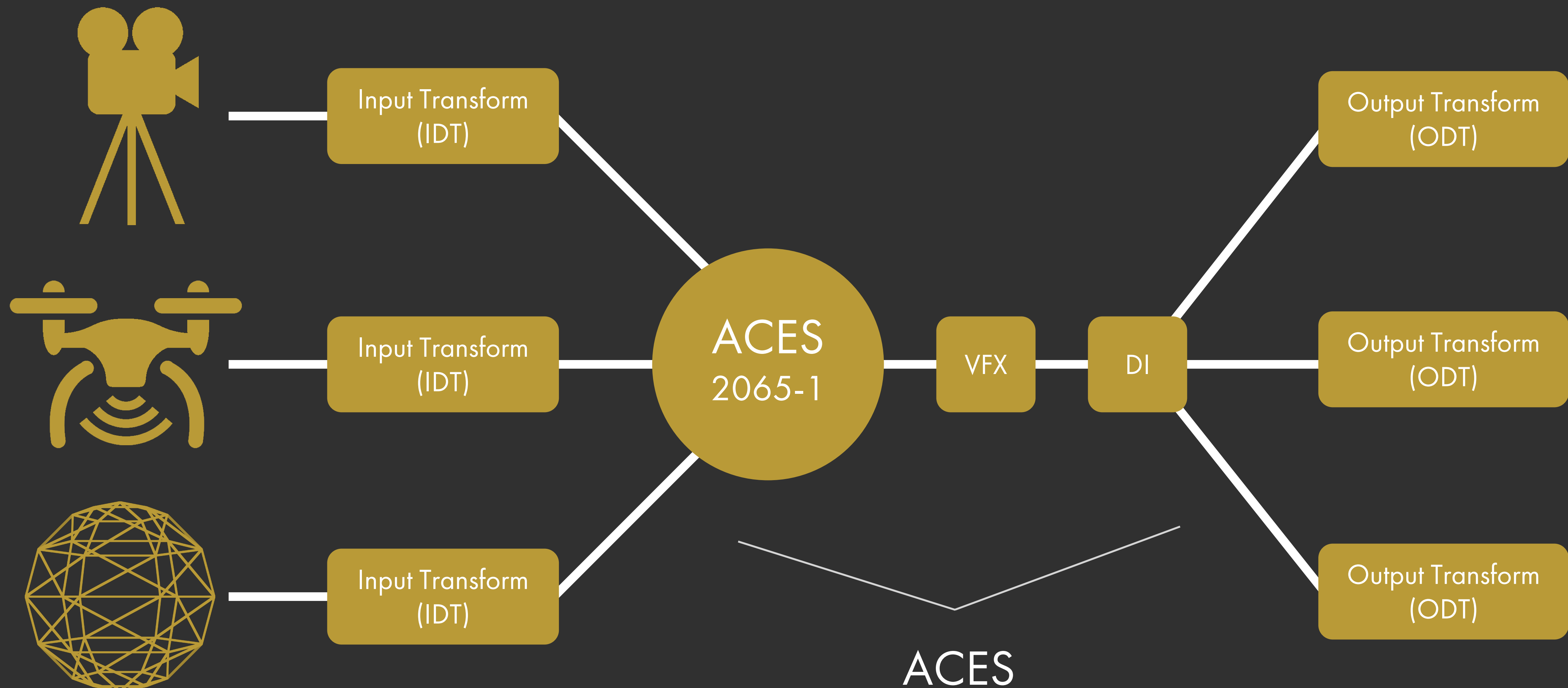
Productions that are **multi-camera** and **multi-vendor** can keep color and file formats **consistent** and **re-usable**
